



BIOGRAPHY

Shamsi Music is a jazz & afro-jazz fusion band from Nairobi Kenya, which prides itself in creating memorable musical experiences that capture the heart, mind and soul. The band set the core of their musical journey as the desire to create music that mirrors the sound of their heartland, Kenya, and their Motherland, Africa.

The band was officially formed in October 2014 after playing together at a charity concert event earlier that year and realizing that there was more that the unit could offer the music industry. Barely two years later, after being rejected twice by Kenya's biggest live event, The Safaricom International Jazz Festival, Shamsi Music became the youngest band ever to be selected to play on that same platform as one of the Kenyan bands in the 2016/2017 season of the festival. They quickly gained admiration and raving support from fans and critiques alike, with people quickly falling in love with their music (see attached press quotes). They proceeded to win the Café Ngoma Award for Best Jazz Act 2017 and 2018.

In April 2018, they became the first ever Safaricom International Jazz Festival (2014 - 2018) export, after they were selected to play at the Festival Jazzy Koum Ben in Bamako, Mali. They have proceeded to play several events and festivals in the region and are poised to dominate the regional Afro Jazz scene and make notable contributions to the wider international Jazz and World Music scene.

Their sound can be described as Kenyan folk jazz eclectically infused with a predominant afro jazz influence, enchanting melodies and solid African rhythms. Shamsi is Swahili-Arabic for "Sun". They desire to be a light to the world and music industry, creating music that refreshes, inspires and gives hope, for God's glory.

Their sophomore album AfroSynthesis is set for release in August 2019 and promises to be explosive! Their masterfully crafted debut album, "The Audition", includes collaboration with master percussionists Tetu Shani and (Ted Fellow) Kasiva Mutua. among other gifted musicians.




